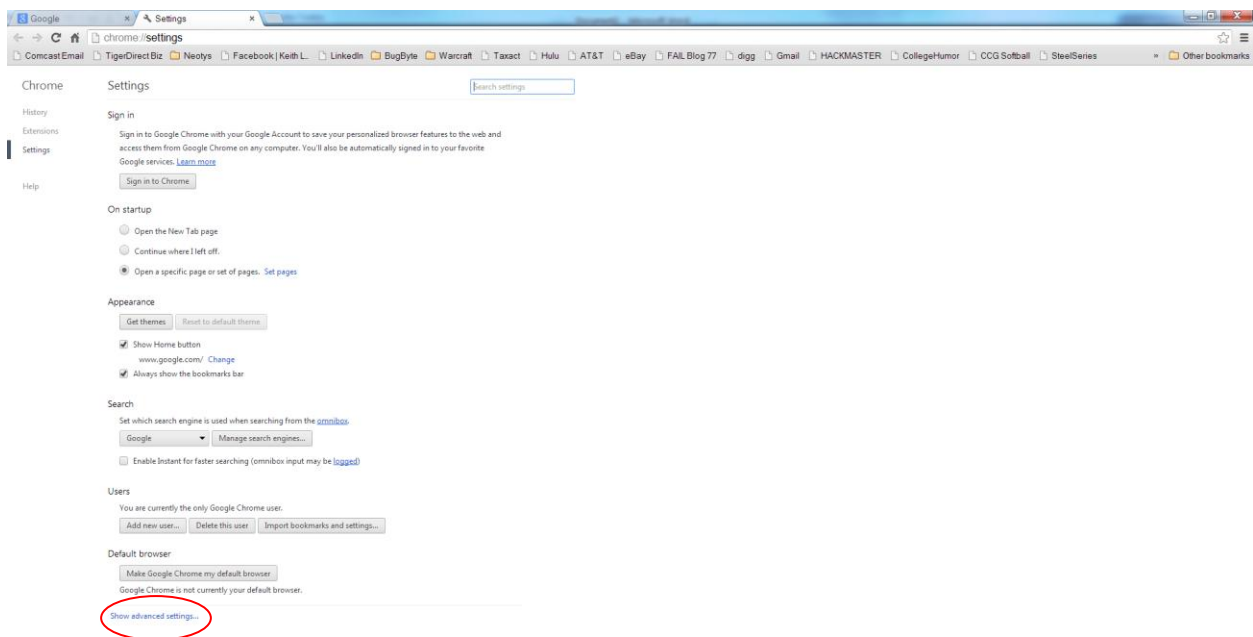
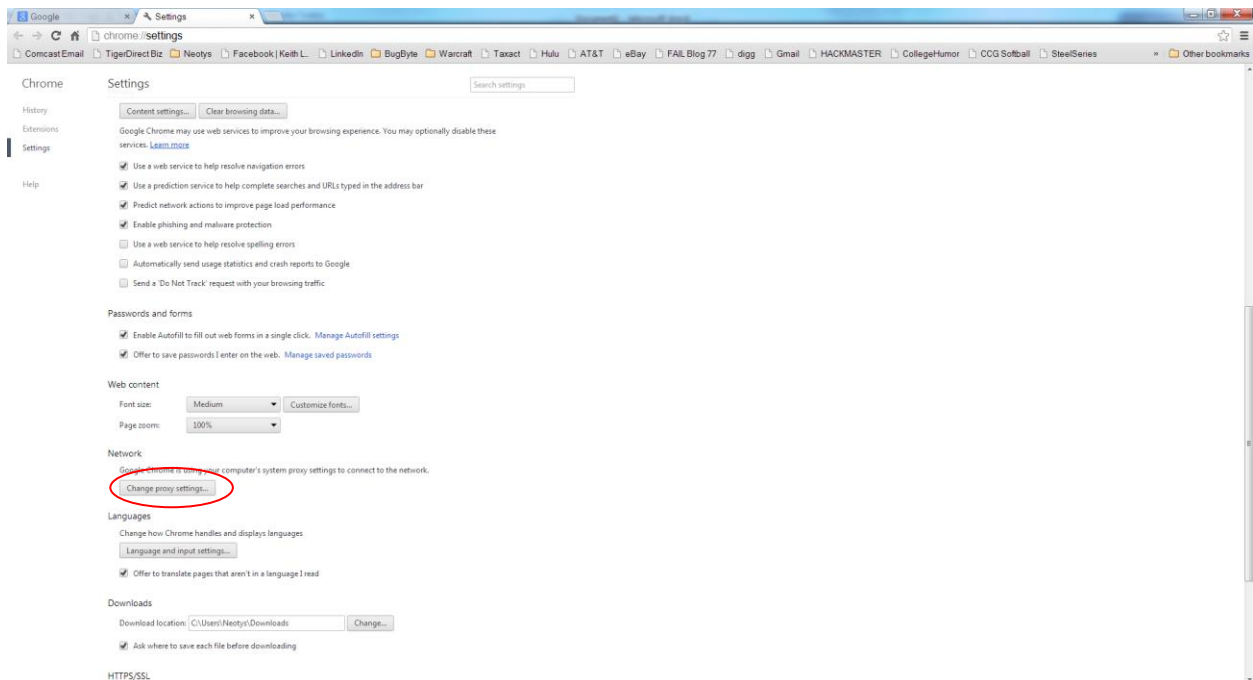


Click on Menu button in top-right corner, then on Settings.

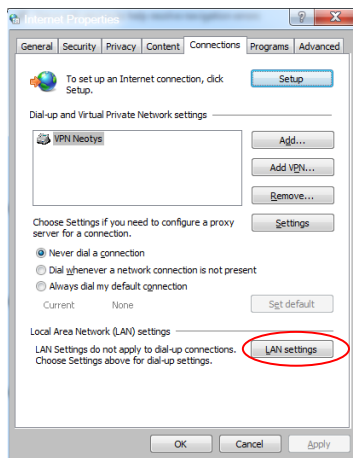
You will see the following screen...



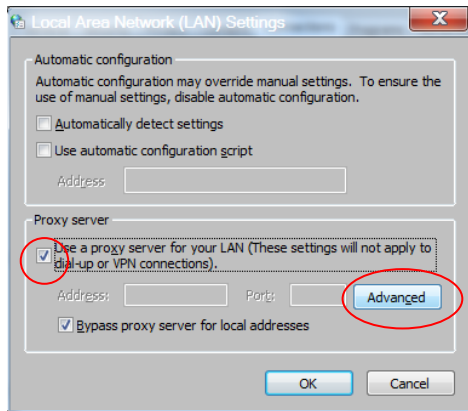
Click on "Show advanced Settings..." to get to Network settings. After selecting and scrolling down, you will see...



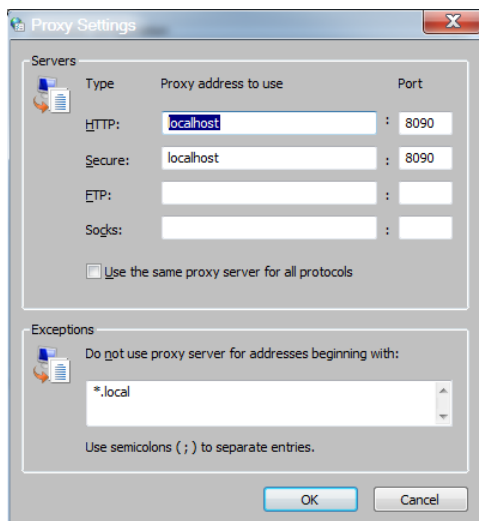
Select "Change proxy settings..." button. You will see...



Select "LAN settings" button to view/change proxy info. You will see...



Select "Use a proxy server..." checkbox and click the "Advanced" button to check or change the proxy settings...



Make sure in the HTTP and Secure (HTTPS) fields you have "localhost" or the Controller's IP address, and port 8090 (default), or whatever you might have changed the recording port to if applicable. Save everything by clicking OK button, and test recording now with Neoload using Chrome.

Note: You will have to uncheck that box above to disable using a proxy for Chrome when using it for normal usage.
